



Hotel lifeguard saves child who nearly drowned

A female lifeguard at the Mirage Hotel Fujairah has been honoured by the Ministry of Interior for resuscitating a two-year-old child who nearly drowned in the pool.

Angel Nakabiito also got a letter of recognition from the hotel and a lifetime lifeguard refresher training and licence renewals from Blue Guard ME.

Sharing her experience, Nakabiito said: "I saw that a toddler had drowned from consuming pool water, and my first reaction was to perform CPR. I followed protocol, gave him five initial breaths and thankfully was able to resuscitate him. I'm extremely happy and proud of myself because I saved a life!"
